Highlights of Prevention Centers' efforts:



Life Skills

Central Florida:

Has hosted the Annual Walk for Recovery, Life Skills Classes, Family Fun Nights, and Red Ribbon Week Activities. Implements New Horizons Program and Too Good for Drugs and Violence. Distributes the Prevention Newsletter.

Reached over 429,396 people since 2003.

Recovery

East Central Florida:

Has hosted various events including Ride for Recovery, Recovery Photography, and Run for Recovery since 2006 to present. Implements Life Skills Program, Safe Date Program, Family Education, and the Strengthening Families Approach.

Reached over 651,515 people since 2006.

Workplace Prevention

Northeast:

Implemented the Gang Prevention Program from 2010-2012 and worked with the Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts from 2010-2011. Taught Life Skills program since 2010.



Reached over 3,924,469 people since 2003

Evidence-Based Programs

Panhandle:

Has implemented prevention and evidence-based programs in middle and high school settings since 1998 to present. Funds Project Graduation and Red Ribbon Week activities. Also, disseminates information on the dangers of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs.

Reached over 176,789 people since 2002.

KKDF tag revenues fund these and other programs.



Families

South Florida:

Has hosted Recovery Picnic since 2005 and Reunification Day for the last 3 years. Pre and Post tested over 1,500 teens during the last two years. Has co-hosted Parent Café awareness for substance abuse and other issues.



Reached over 483,121 people since 2004.

ATOD Awareness

Sun Coast Region:

Held Youth Essay Contest for 10 years and supports Operation Medicine Cabinet, NOPE Vigil, and Last Drink Survey. Attends Town Hall Meetings and provides trainings.
